- 4. Publish your project into CoverPage Viewer

Preparing your content



How to prepare layout

- Create your catalogue layout using the tool you prefer, such as Adobe InDesign, Photoshop, QuarkXPress or even Apple iBook Author
- Export as PDF, JPEGs/ PNGs or use CoverPage InDesign export plugin
- Import layout resources into CoverPage Publisher

How to create interactive content

- Create project in CoverPage Publisher for iPad2 or retina iPad3 layout
- Import layout resources
- · Use interactive and multimedia tools to add extra content

How to publish and distribute via App Store

- Switch into "Publish section" in CoverPage Publisher and setup your publishing parameters
- Press "Publish" button to deliver content into your CoverPage account
- See your published project in CoverPage Viewer
- Create Users Viewers in your CoverPage Web Account
- Link your projects with Viewers in your CoverPage Web Account
- Provide the unique access data to specific clients Viewer

How to have my own Branded Viewer or White label

- Send us all necessary information (graphics and text resources) for delivering your App to Apple
- If you have your own Apple Dev Account, we build App binary file you can download
- If you don't have an Apple Developer account we are happy to assist you with its submission.
- Wait until your App is approved by Apple and simply let your clients know where they can find your Branded Viewer App (use links, App Store badges, etc.)

Do I need Apple Dev Account?

Only **if you want to have your own Custom Branded Viewer** or White labeling, we highly recommend creating your own Apple Developer Account. You have full control over your App. We can help you with Dev Account Submission.

What is White labeling feature for my Viewer?

If you want to look more professional with only your branding we have an offer of White labeling. All Apps based on CoverPage platform are coming with small CoverPage logo on splash screen and its copyright in information window. You can use White label feature and have your app without any CoverPage logos. With White Label feature you will have custom branded App without our branding.

How can I get my Branded Viewer to Google Play Store?

We build an Android Application package file (APK) file for you and you simply upload this file to your Google Play account. Define price, description or any required information and publish.*

What If I need to show one project to only one client?

You can easily link your clients with the projects. **Use CoverPage Web Account,** <u>create Viewer</u> and link to particular projects so it won't be visible to anyone else.

What is the maximum project size?

There is **no limitation of project size**. But beware of device disk space. Too **large projects may influence the device performance** and also will need to be deleted by user soon after downloading it to save the space for other apps, projects and such as.

What platforms do you use?

CoverPage platform is **multi platform solution**. You can publish content for iPad, iPhone, Desktop and Android*.

Is CoverPage Viewer available in Google Play Store?
