## RoHS declaration

The European RoHS directive 2011/65/EU and its amendment 2015/863/EU restrict the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

The concerned (10) substances are:

- Mercury
- Lead
- Hexavalent chromium
- Cadmium
- Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

The RoHS conformity is covered by CE marking, for all of our products which are in the categories between 1 and 11 (according Annex I of the directive 2011/65/EU) the conformity of both directives is included in our EU declaration.

## REACH Declaration

The REACH regulation entered into force on June 1<sup>st</sup> 2007. Regarding human health and environment the target is to manufacture and to use only safe substances inside the EU.

Hager Group designs, manufactures and sells electro technical products. Considering the terms of the regulation, Hager Group manufactures “articles” and is a “downstream-user”.

We check that our suppliers comply to REACH requirements for all the materials and components they deliver to us.

Hager Group was always committed to supply his customers with environmental friendly products. Hager Group also complies to REACH regulation.

For the “SVHC candidate list” and as requested by article 33 of the regulation, Hager Group will provide his customers with information about the chemicals of “very high concern” if some of them will be present in our products with a rate greater than 0.1%.
