

#### RESORT

A former cultural institution and boarding school turned luxury hotel, Collegio alla Querce, Auberge Resorts Collection will encompass three adjacent 16th-century buildings, including an original chapel and theatre. An extensive transformation awakens the property's storied and romantic history, dating back to the Italian Renaissance, through a rarefied art collection, distinct architecture and design, and spectacular, manicured gardens. Surrounded by soaring oak trees, a nod to Collegio alla Querce's name, the resort's grounds boast expansive lawns and five levels of terraced Baroque gardens, a work of art in itself.

#### ACCOMMODATIONS

In harmonious design, Collegio alla Querce,
Auberge Resorts Collection marries the old and
new worlds, fusing the brand's signature,
approachable luxury design with the building's
Renaissance-era historic architecture.
Reimagined into an 83-room hotel, the resort
features 69 guest rooms, 14 suites and a
2,250-square-foot signature suite. A rich
palette of taupe and cabernet reds harmonize
with contemporary furnishings and hand-selected
objets d'art, while large windows look over
manicured Baroque gardens and spectacular
hilltop views of the historic city.

#### WELLNESS

The Auberge Spa takes inspiration from the ubiquitous wine country of neighboring Tuscany. Slow wellbeing practices are tailored to each guest in four treatment rooms that each offer their own private sauna and steam rooms.

#### LOCATION

Tucked down a cypress-lined entrance north of Florence's cobblestoned centro storico, wrought-iron gates open onto Collegio alla Querce, an exquisite cluster of reimagined 16th-century UNESCO buildings. Embracing two worlds, one side of the hotel offers baroque gardens that gaze upon panoramic views of the iconic Duomo and terracotta Florentine cityscape, while the opposite side overlooks miles of lush Chianti vineyards in Tuscany.

Located in Via della Piazzuola, just 15 minutes from Florence's International airport.

#### DINING

An enchanting dining destination, Collegio alla Querce celebrates old-world Italian allure in style and experience. The varied offerings include a destination restaurant, a glass-enclosed garden room for daytime dining, a sophisticated bar and cigar lounge set in the former academic admissions office, and an outdoor pool bar offering wood fired bites and cocktails.
