- Objective: vocational training leading to qualifications
- Promotor: Public Employment Office in Flanders
- P= Offered Price per individual action
- N= Intended employment-rate
- PES activities paid on output and outcome basis
- $\text{output} = P * 80\%$; $\text{outcome} = P * 20\% / N$
- $\text{ESF financing} = (P \times 80\%) \times \text{number of people} + (P \times 20\%) / N \times \text{number of people employed}$



- Draft Evaluation Plan ROP ERDF-ESF Burgundy (Bourgogne) with 230 mio Euro
- well designed/comprehensive plan with clear timetable for scheduled evaluations
 - **Process Before 2018 (with most funds): research, energy transition, ESF, process, communication/HP**
 - **Impact After 2018: research, SME, ICT, energy transition, ESF, urban, biodiversity, final evaluation**
- budget indications, good description of the evaluation process and the actors involved, analysis of the challenges for Burgundy and the presentation forms covering all specific objectives (SO), containing concrete evaluation questions, suggesting a good alignment of results with the set SO.
