Animal husbandry is a fundamental social and economic paradigm, and the Foundation has supported special policies for improving the lifestyle of the herdsmen. The Foundation is also trying to implement several programmes and measures for safeguarding ICH, especially for young people. They have initiated measures, such as organizing a national campaign over the past 2-3 years on safeguarding traditional practices of sacred sites which cover all ICH domains and involve all people of Mongolia. They also arrange for children to be taught about the sites, including urban dwellers who live too far from the sacred sites to visit them.
