DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF CONSENT OF COMMUNITIES

SURIJAGEK

Suri Jagek (observing the Sun) is a traditional meteorological Kalasha practice of observing the Sun, Moon and Stars throughout the year. It plays pivotal role as a living calendar for the community with social events being governed by the position of the Moon, Sun and Stars. *Suri Jagek* is a practice that rules the entire Kalasha culture by outlining the specific times for various occasions such as: festivals, feasts, rituals and farming practices. The practice plays a prominent role in forecasting weather and predicting natural disasters and was a major element governing the daily lives of the Kalasha community. This is a fast disappearing element of indigenous Kalasha knowledge concerning Nature and Universe since people have started relying on the Gregorian calendar and dates for various social events are fixed and set in advance. We as representatives of the Kalash community agree to this practice being placed on UNESCO's Urgent Safeguarding List since we feel that this is a vital part of our heritage which needs protection.

سوری جاگیک (سورج کا مشاہدہ کرنا)، کلاشہ کمیونٹی کا روایتی و موسیقیاتی علم جو کہ سورج، چاند اور ستاروں کا مشاہدہ کرنے سے ہے۔ یہ کلاشہ کمیونٹی کا زندہ کیلنڈر بنانے میں اہم کردار ادا کرتا ہے، جس سے وابستہ کمیونٹی کی اہم سماجی تقریبات ہیں۔ کمیونٹی کے تہوار، رسومات کے خاص وقت اور تیاری، جانوروں کی دیکھ بھال سے وابستہ علم، موسم اور قدرتی آفات کی پیشگوئیاں سارے سوری جاگیک سے متعلق ہیں۔ یہ ایک جلد ختم ہوتا ہوا علم ہے جس کو جلد جاتی کیلنڈر، اور مزید تکنیکی تاریخوں سے خطرہ ہے۔ ہم کلاشہ کمیونٹی کے نمائندے اس بات پر مستحق ہیں کہ سوری جاگیک کو یونیسکو کی ارجنٹ سیف گارڈڈ لسٹ میں شامل کیا جائے، کیونکہ ہم اس کو اپنی وراثت کا ایک اہم حصہ سمجھتے ہیں جس کو محفوظ کرنے کی ضرورت ہے۔

Signatory consent has been gained with representation of the three valleys. Care has been taken to include a diverse age group considering their integral role in the safeguarding of the practice.

***note: The Kalasha is a diverse group with different tribal, sub-tribal, and clan based affiliations. Some individuals in the list represent a major tribe, sub-tribe, and clan, thereby falling in three different categories. Some individuals however, choose to affiliate with only their major tribe, sub-tribe or clan. ***


