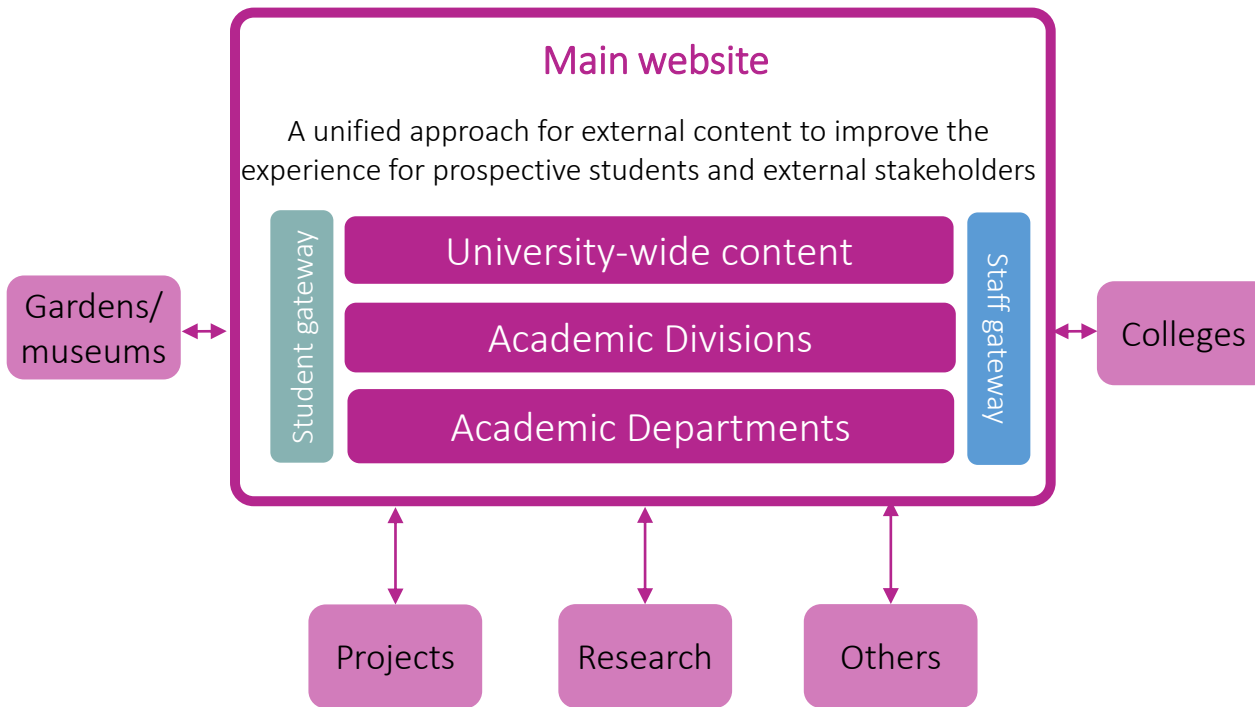

Oxford Fresco

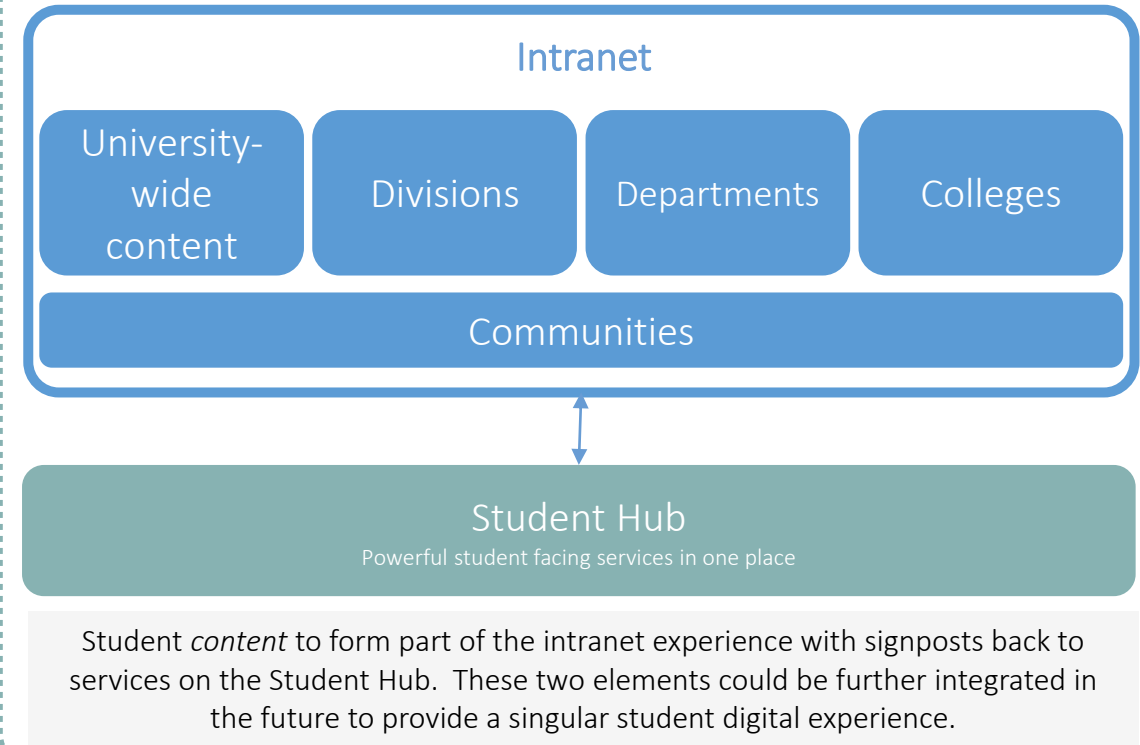
A single CMS platform that allows central, division, department and college autonomous publishing under one umbrella

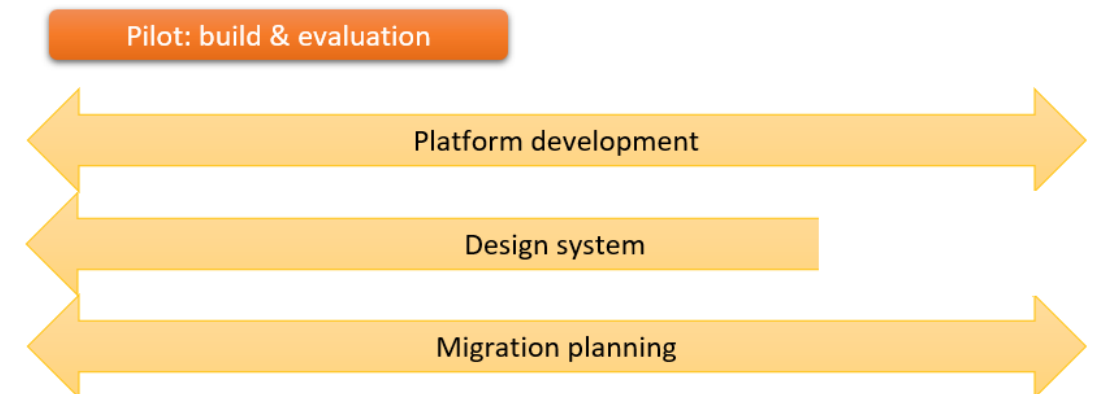

Oxford Fresco – Oxweb progress

Planning

- Rough timeline for migration agreed with Oxweb Delivery Group
- Information & Digital Committee (IDC) have now endorsed the extended timeline (beyond January 2025)

Content

- Continuing content audit work with divisional sites & UAS leads in preparation for IA development

Training

- Developing initial content-focused training

Oxweb requirements

- Working with the Platform team to flesh out requirements

User research

- User research & design testing with prospective students, students and other audiences planned for coming weeks

Oxford Fresco – design progress

Progress to date:

Discovery phase complete:

- 3 workshops held with Oxweb Delivery Group plus wider stakeholders
- Creative brief developed
- Numiko met with Oxweb team to look at comparison sites and ‘moodboards’

Concept phase in progress:

- Draft framework approach for feedback
- Initial concept designs for feedback

Oxford Fresco – design framework approach

3 categories for customisation (all applicable at the 'block' or 'slice' level):

- **Structure:**
When selecting a slice or block, a creator would be able to choose from a variety of structural options – eg left-aligned, right-aligned, centred, whether to include an image or not, etc
- **Theme:**
Colour combinations, typeface and embellishments (rounded vs square corners, etc)
- **Motion:**
Users would be able to select from 2-3 predefined motion languages for their design

Elements to consider:


- How to simplify for users (templates, presets, etc)
- Defining all the available applications

- ✓ A personalised homepage that delivers news and updates tailored to your users' role, location and the communities they belong to
- ✓ Discover, connect with, and access people, content and tools across University of Oxford
- ✓ Powered by 'Appspace', built on top of Oxford's SharePoint technology, with enhanced people data
- ✓ Connect with people and communities across Oxford
- ✓ Access to the key applications and information we need to do our jobs

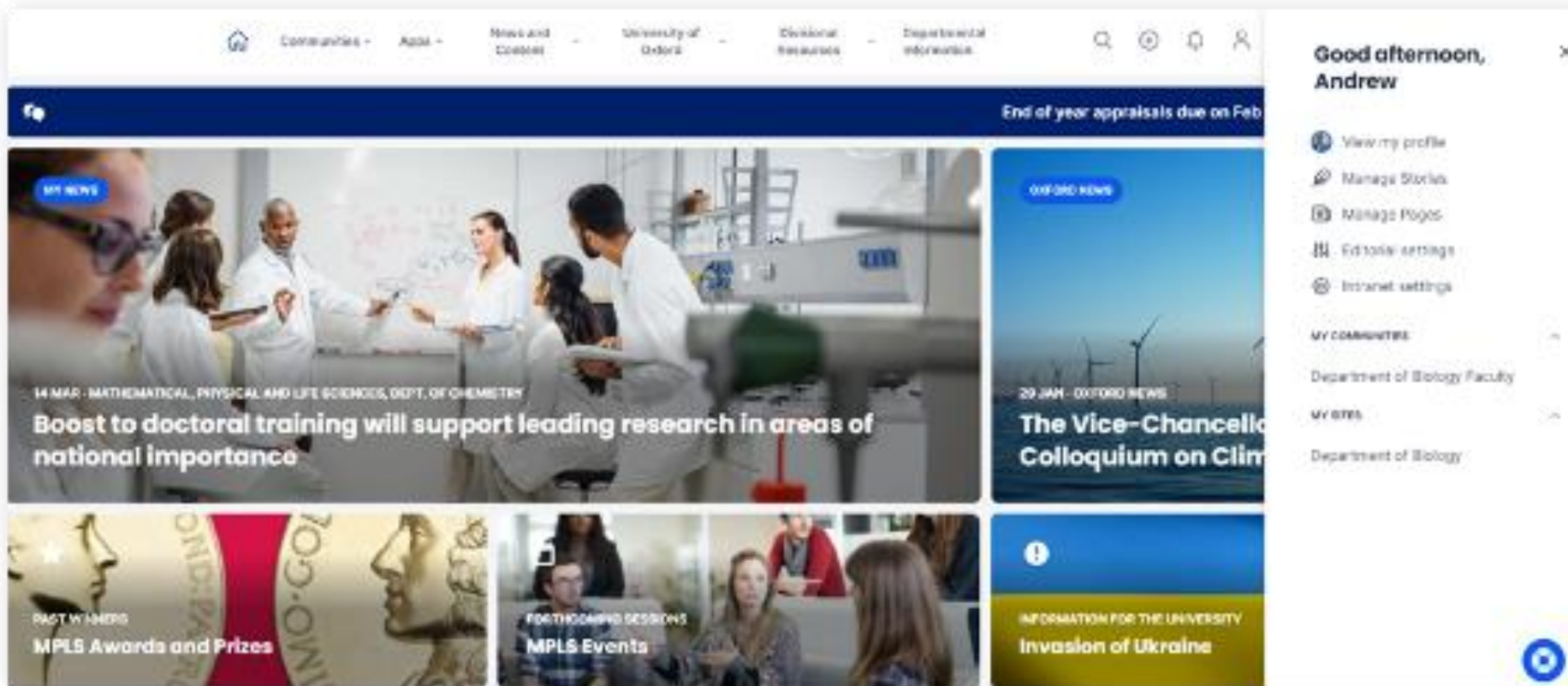

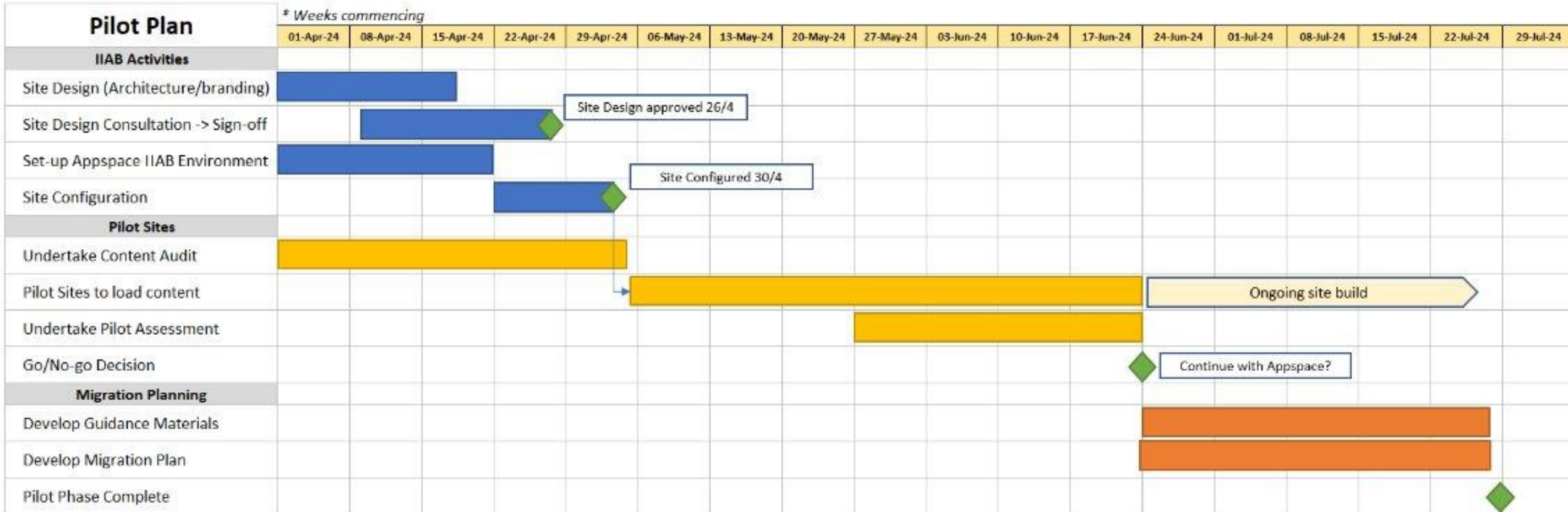

Migration

- Migration from current Mosaic sites will begin in September 2024.
- Destination for content based on the Content Strategy:
 - Mosaic site to Fresco
 - Mosaic site to Oxweb on Fresco
 - Mosaic site to Ox-Intranet
 - Mosaic site to combination of above
- Migration is a large and complex activity – impact will vary
- Analysis and approach underway
- By the end of May we plan to share with divisions:
 - Proposed migration scheduling
 - Information regarding what support and help will be available for migration
