Ambassador of Chile

The Ambassador joined the "Andrés Bello" Diplomatic Academy of Chile in 1980.

Ambassador Fernández has served at the Chilean Embassies in Romania, Switzerland, Brazil, Malaysia, Belgium, France, Mexico and in the Mission to the European Union. He was also General Consul of Chile in Chicago, United States.

In Chile, Ambassador Fernandez has worked in different areas of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs: he has been in charge of the United States desk; he worked for the Directorate for Multilateral Affairs and for the Europe Directorate; he was appointed as Head of the Content Unit of the 1998 Summit of the Americas as well as General Coordinator of the 2004 APEC Summit of Leaders. He was also Chief of Cabinet of the Undersecretary of Foreign Affairs between 2010 and 2012.

Mr. Fernández was appointed Ambassador of Chile to Haiti in 2013. He became Ambassador to the European Union, the Kingdom of Belgium and Luxembourg in 2017. He took the position of Secretary General for Foreign Policy on October 2019.

Since March 2021 he has served as Ambassador of Chile in Canada.

Ambassador Fernández has been awarded the Order of Isabel La Católica (Officer) and the Order of Malta in 1990 (Officer).

He is married, father of 3 children and grandfather of 3 grandchildren.
