

## **HESI Action Group webinar - SDG Publishers Compact**

The Higher Education Sustainability Initiative (HESI) is an open partnership between several United Nations entities and the higher education community to highlight the critical role of higher education in achieving sustainable development. The HESI Community is made up of hundreds of university networks, student organizations, and higher education institutions. Any relevant higher education institution or network may join HESI.

HESI includes four Action Groups<sup>1</sup> that tackle specific topics related to higher education for sustainable development. Action groups draw upon the full HESI community to carry out its work and is often composed of several organizations and contributors.

Aligning academic research and education with the SDGs is crucial for a sustainable future. The HESI Action Group "<u>SDG Publishers Compact</u>" is a multi-stakeholder working group of sustainability experts, practitioners and academic leaders supporting the <u>SDG Publishers Compact</u>, launched by the International Publishers Association and the United Nations in 2020.

The Group focuses on describing emerging international trends to put the SDGS into practice in academic research and education, redefining impact and providing resources to help educators, researchers, journal editors and publishers. The group is also focused on connecting practitioners and policymakers to researchers to co-create research, inform research agendas and better utilize research results.
