
## OUTCOME-FOCUSED

**2.PRACTITIONERS** E.g. improved skills of coaches, teachers, health workers, etc.

### **INSTITUTIONS**

**3. ORGANISATIONS**E.g. Improved capacity of NOCs and sport federations, local government departments, youth development organisations, health providers, etc.

### **SYSTEMS**

**4. POLICY**E.g. Policy change supporting sport in schools, sport infrastructure in planning etc.

**5. SOCIAL ATTITUDES**E.g. Reach and impact of campaigns, incl. digital engagement and interactions.


