## IOC Policy Regarding Certain NOC Scientific and Medical Equipment for the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris in 2024

As a matter of general policy, it is prohibited for any National Olympic Committee (“**NOC**”) or member of its delegation to bring any of the following scientific or medical equipment (“**Equipment**”) into or around any Olympic Venue during the Period of the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris in 2024:

- (i) Oxygen tanks and cylinders
- (ii) Hypoxic or hyperoxic tents or chambers
- (iii) Cryogenic chambers for whole body cryotherapy

It is the responsibility of each NOC to ensure compliance with this Policy by all members of its delegation. Failure to respect this Policy may expose the Athlete(s), the entourage of the Athlete(s), the NOC and members of its delegation, as well as the persons involved, to disciplinary measures and/or sanctions in application of Rule 59 of the Olympic Charter.

Further information relating to the processing of personal data in the context of investigations related to alleged failure to respect this Policy and any subsequent sanction proceedings is contained in the Information Notice on the processing of personal data of participants and other accredited persons for the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris in 2024 (as attached to the Conditions of Participation form).

For the purposes of this Policy, the following definitions shall apply:

“*Olympic Venue*” shall mean all venues which require an Olympic accreditation card or ticket to gain entry, including the Olympic Village(s), the competition venues, and the training and practice venues.

“*Period of the Games of the XXXIII Olympiad in Paris in 2024*” shall mean the period from the opening of the Olympic Village(s) on 12 July 2024 until the closing of the Olympic Village(s) on 13 August 2024.
