Effective July 1, 2024, Sandata is providing new validation responses. These responses are visible in the aggregator, and detail why a claim did not meet EVV compliance:

- "Recipient ID does not match" will return when the Recipient Medicaid ID does not show as "assigned to the requested provider shown in the aggregator".
- "Procedure code does not match" is essentially a No Visit Found. Please confirm that the six points of EVV validation are listed correctly in the aggregator, as well as on the submitted claim:
 - Individual Provider Medicaid ID
 - Rendering Provider Medicaid ID
 - Correct Payer
 - Date of Service
 - Service Provided (CPT codes)
 - Number of Units

EVV is a Federal regulation enforced by the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) and compliance is mandatory.

Additionally, CareSource requires an 85% compliance rate for all services requiring EVV validation by June 30, 2024.
