## **Submission Guidelines:**

- Photo Format: High-resolution (at least 240 dpi, best if 300 dpi. To find out about the resolution, you can right-click on the photo, Properties->Details->Image horizontal/vertical resolution. JPEG or PNG files. They can be landscape or portrait, taken in the past 5 years.
- **Copyright:** Please ensure that you own the rights for the image or that you have the express permission of the copyright holder. This is the responsibility of the submitter and UNESCO will not be held responsible for misattribution.
- Caption or photo description: A sentence (up to 30 words) describing the scene of the photo, including the project name, location, date and the context of the image.
- Short text (up to 150 words) explaining the work of the UNESCO Chair /UNITWIN Network, including key achievements.

- Deadline: Please submit your photographs and captions by <u>31 August.</u>
