



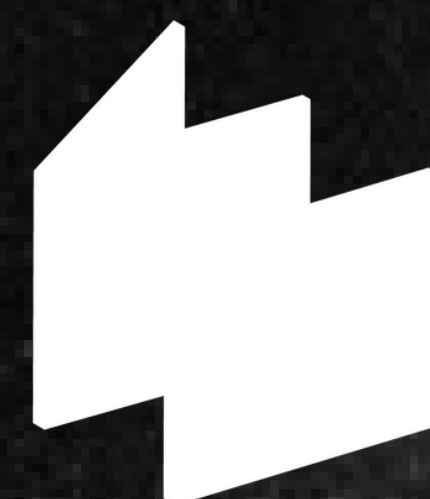
Bessie Coleman
